Who was your favorite “secondary character?” (villain or not) and why? What was it about them that made them fun to read? If you could pick one of those characters to be, which would it be and why?

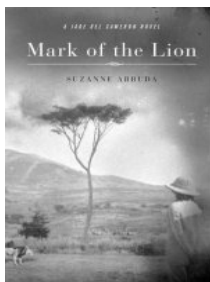
